



KEYHOLE TO HISTORY

On-Line Patriotic Education Program

Announcing a free on-line educational program sponsored by the Governor Isaac Shelby Chapter (Middletown, Kentucky) of the Sons of the American Revolution. All students in grades 4-12 are invited to participate.

The goal of the program is to promote knowledge and interest in American history. The various segments of the program engage the listener in the lives of Revolutionary War patriots and nation building events with professionally produced material.

The program consists of 52 one-minute audio presentations available on-line. The presentations highlight selected American Revolutionary War battles, famous Patriots, the American flag, and historic events. A question related to each history presentation can then be answered by the student on the worksheet available from the website.
