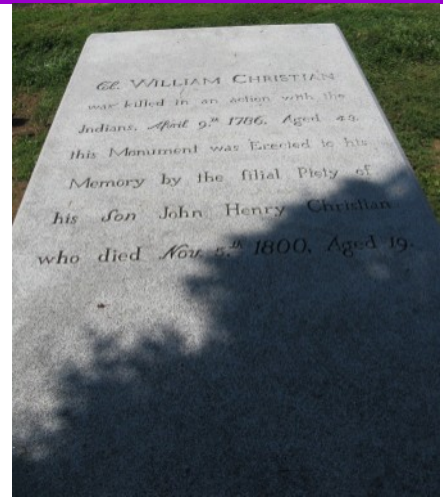
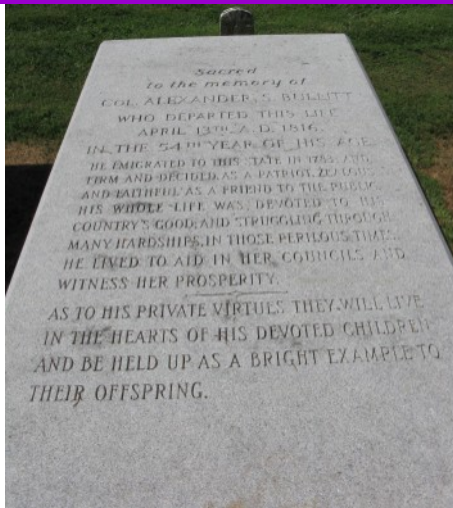

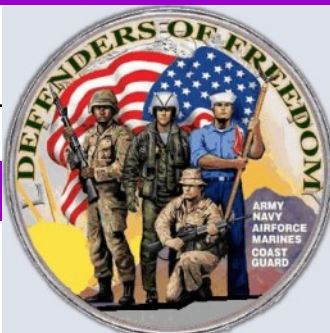
“Parting Glass” introduced at Grave Marking Service
